

Construction has begun and we have officially **“broken ground”** and had our **first concrete pour!**

In order to provide a safe route to the construction site that does not interfere with school operations, a temporary driveway has been installed along the exterior parking lot fence line. Throughout the course of construction, large trucks and pieces of equipment will drive on this road to get from the street to the construction site.

Additionally, as the road is at the top of a small hill, we need to take measures to ensure it remains stable. The location of the temporary road is in the location of the future parking lot extension, so the retaining wall that will support the new parking lot is being built now to also support the temporary construction driveway.
