How do WE think about Distance Learning?

- <u>Parent Ease</u>: The system we put in place must provide support to and for families. The
 information and the process need to be user-friendly and accessible for parents, if they
 are expected to teach and assist scholars at home.
- Supports our most vulnerable: The system that is put in place must be a system that supports our most struggling learner or household.
- Prevents Learning Loss: We serve a population that is dependent upon us for quality instruction. Because of this, our floor for virtual learning up to this point was to prevent learning loss, not to introduce new concepts or skills. With closure being extended through the end of the year, our quarter 4 plans go above and beyond this minimal expectation and introduce new skills and information to scholars. Learning hours are more important than ever.

Because of this, scholars' grades will not be negatively impacted during this time of distance learning.




- Quarter 3: February 3rd April 24th

- Scholars who do not complete distance learning work by the specified timeline will not be penalized and will receive the quarter 3 grade they earned as of March 13, prior to the closure.

Quarter 4 Learning & Grading

Our current situation requires a **shift in our grading policies and procedures**. Our scholars have **varied levels of access and supports** while experiencing learning at home. Because of this, we have crafted a grading policy that provides opportunities for **scholars to demonstrate what they have learned that will not negatively impact their overall grades.**



Virtual Teaching & Learning Hours Continue

There will be no changes to the times of our **Virtual Teaching & Learning Hours**.

- Learning Hours are conducted daily via ZOOM: 9AM-11AM and 2PM-4PM.
- Physical Education available daily via ZOOM: 11:15AM-11:50AM and 12PM-12:45PM. (This is not for a grade)
- ***Remember families scholars will have <u>new information</u> in this quarter's materials so learning hours are critical. They need teacher support.***
- Teachers will continue to support scholars during learning hours through various means including, but not limited to, mini-lessons, clarifying misconceptions, small group or individual instructional support, modeling thinking, and reviewing scholar work and providing feedback.

Quarter 4 Grading Policy

- Quarter 4: Begins April 27th through end of school year
- Scholars will receive either a Pass (P) or No Grade (NG) for Quarter 4.
- A Pass would be assigned when a scholar completes the assigned work in the Distance Learning Workbooks.
- A 'NG' would be assigned when a scholar does not complete the assigned work in the Distance Learning Workbooks.
- For the Fourth Quarter, a Pass would factor into final grades as a 100%. An 'NG' would not factor into the final grade calculation.



End of Year Final Grade Calculation

- 1. <u>If a scholar earns a "P" during Quarter 4, it would equate to a 100 for Quarter 4.</u> It would then be averaged with the other three quarters, each quarter counting as 25% of the final grade.
- 2. <u>If a scholar receives an "NG" during Quarter 4, it would not factor into the final grade calculation</u>. The other three quarters would be averaged, each counting as approximately 33% of the final grade.
- 3. Families will have access to Quarter 4 and EOY report cards in PowerSchool beginning on Tuesday, May 26. Parent teacher conferences May 27th.



Promotion and Retention Policy

- No scholar will be penalized from progressing to the next grade due to the absence of in-person intervention supports available during this period of extended school closures. **By May 15**, school leaders will reach out to the families of scholars who were not on track for promotion prior to closure and/or who are not meeting promotion criteria to discuss what is in the best interest of the scholar for next school year.
- For the 2020-2021 SY, no scholar will be retained unless the family and the school agree that it is in the scholar's best interest. In addition, scholars who have already been retained once should not be retained for another year even if the family and school agree that retention would be in the scholar's best interest.

Quarter 4 Workbook Drop-Off

- Families should drop off all scholar work for Quarter 4 on these dates:
 - Monday, May 18th between 10AM 2PM
 - Tuesday, May 19th between 1PM 5PM
- Reminders will be sent to families by email, robocall, the
